The Speed Mentoring concept

Young girls aged between 12 and 25 were given the opportunity, for the fourth consecutive year, to meet active women from the Principality: business leaders, self-employed professionals, and women holding senior positions in both the private and public sectors.

Through a Speed Mentoring format, they had the opportunity to ask questions to several women of their choice about their career paths, studies, choices, successes and challenges, in order to better understand the range of possible career paths.

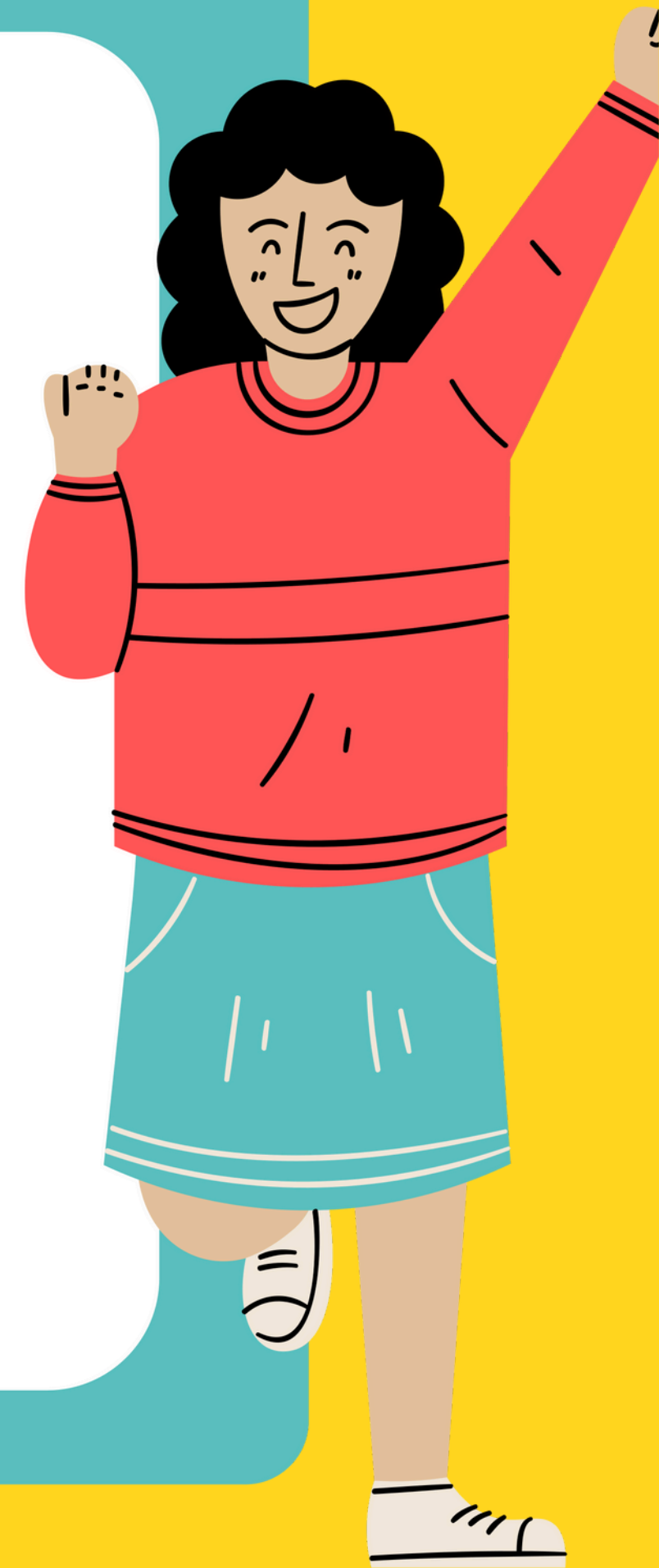
